PALM SUNDAY
📖 John 12:13

● Jesus Christ experienced the most incredible and important days of all of history. No one **lived** like Jesus. No one **died** like Jesus. No one **lives again** like Jesus!

● The first of the three “24” days we want to focus on is Palm Sunday. The Day of Worship.

THE DAY OF WORSHIP.

📖 John 12:12-19

- ⇒ Though many people had gotten off the **Jesus bandwagon**, many were still in **awe** of Him!

■ **WHAT DOES THIS DAY MEAN?**

Theologically.

- ⇒ Jesus presented Himself officially to the nation as **Messiah** and the **Son of God!**
📖 1 Corinthians 5:7
- ⇒ They shouted “*Hosanna!*” which came means **“Save us now!”**

Prophetically.

- ⇒ **Past.** 📖 Zechariah 9:9
- ⇒ **Future.** 📖 Philippians 2:9-11

Practically.

- ⇒ Palm Sunday give insight about **worship.**

■ **FOUR KINDS OF WORSHIPPERS.**

- ⇒ **Band wagon** worshippers.
 - ⇒ The Day of Worship reminds us to guard against **superficial** acclaim for Jesus.
- ⇒ **Buzz seeker** worshippers.
 - ⇒ The Day of Worship reminds us that **true faith** does not need razzle dazzle, smoke and lightning to be real.
- ⇒ **Bogus** worshippers.
 - ⇒ The Day of Worship reminds us how important it is to know **who** we are worshipping.
- ⇒ **Bona fide** worshippers.

- I am naming Jesus Christ as my Savior and Master of All!

- I will memorize **Philippians 2:9-11.**
- I will bring someone with me to Good Friday and Easter services.
